Sending Out Mitochondrial M2 Antibody Testing

SUBJECT: Sending Out Mitochondrial M2 Antibody Testing

DLS will be discontinuing our current BioRad Evolis instrumentation and moving those assays onto the more automated BioRad Bioplex Instrumentation to improve operational efficiency. Due to this change, effective April 29, 2024, DLS will no longer be performing Mitochondrial Antibody (Order code 466) testing in-house.

All orders for Mitochondrial Antibody testing will be sent to LabCorp Laboratories. Requests using the old order codes will be converted to the new send-out code.

The turn-around time for this test will be up to 5 days and the results will change from qualitative to semi-quantitative.
